

Teams:

Competition Format:

The competition format varies in each division depending on total number of participating teams.

For instance, there were two pools of play in the men's & women's competition since there were more teams participating in these divisions (10 men teams & 6 women teams) and a single round robin for the 16 & under boy's competition since only 5 municipalities participated.

In the 2012 Liberation Day Basketball Tournament there were 3 phases:

1. Preliminary Phase
2. Knock-out Phase or the "Play-offs"
3. Finals Phase or Medal Games

In the preliminary phase, teams play in their respective pools in a round robin for the men's and women's competition and single round robin pool for the boys. The top ranking teams will advance to the knock-out phase.

In the knock-out phase, teams from the men's & women's division pool play will have the opportunity to play teams from other pool in a criss-cross single elimination matches with the top ranked teams from each pool playing the least ranked teams in each pool. For instance, Pool A rank #1 will play Pool B rank #4 for the men's division.

For the women's division, the top ranked teams from each pool are "bye" with the rank #2 teams from each pool playing the rank #3 teams in a single knock-out match. The two winners will advance and play a semi-final match with the "bye" teams.

Since there were only five 16 & Under Boys teams, the top 4 ranked teams automatically advanced to the semi-finals with the top seats playing the least bottom seat:

#1 v #4 & #2 v #3

Winners of the semi-finals matches from the men's and women's divisions will play in the Gold Medal game or the Finals Phase while the losers (semi-finals) will compete for the Bronze Medal game.

All matches in the 2012 Liberation Day Basketball Tournament were conducted by the rules and regulations of FIBA (International Basketball), the world governing body of basketball associations.

Venue:

Thanks to the collaborative efforts and team spirit of the COM-FSM for allowing the 2012 Liberation Day Basketball Committee to utilize their wonderful facilities: National Campus Gymnasium and Pohnpei Campus Gymnasium.

Without the support of the college, the 2012 Liberation Day Basketball Tournament would not have been successful.

Final Classifications:

The finals phase of the 2012 Liberation Day Basketball Tournament was held on September 8, 9, & 10 at the Pohnpei Campus Gymnasium.

On Saturday September 8, the final matches were played between teams from the 16 & Under Boys Division Finalists with Kapingamarangi & U boys playing for the Bronze Medal at 5:00 pm and Sokehs & Kolonia boys playing for the Gold Medal 7:00 pm.

On Sunday September 9, the medal games were played between teams from the Women's Division Finalists. Playing for the Bronze Medal match was between U & Kapingamarangi at 5:00 pm followed by the Gold Medal match between Kolonia & Kitti.

Monday September 10 was the final day of the 2012 Liberation Day Basketball Tournament and starting off with the conclusion of the tournament was the Men's Bronze Medal match between U & Kolonia. In the Men's Gold Medal match was between Kitti & Nett at 7:30 pm with a very packed gymnasium by spectators, family, friends, supporters, and basketball fanatics.
